GOOD REASONS TO VISIT

- One of the oldest decorated caves in the world.
- The first cave to be listed as a historic monument in 1900.
- The discovery of the Pair-non-Pair cave helped cave art gain recognition.

Discovered in 1881, the Pair-non-Pair cave is decorated with engravings (horses, ibex, deer, mammoths, bovinds, etc.) that represent some of the oldest artistic expressions of humanity (around 30,000 BCE).

Remember to check out the museum space and its display of prehistoric artefacts discovered at the site.

DID YOU KNOW...?

Pair-non-Pair is one of the oldest prehistoric caves, twice as old as Lascaux!

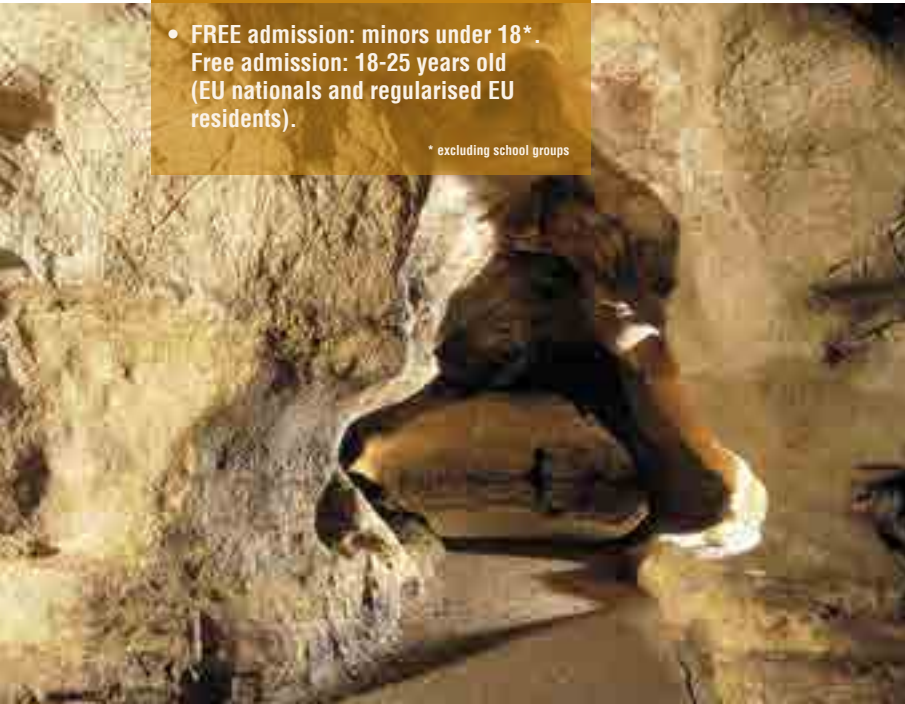
