

Discovered in 1881, the Pair-non-Pair cave is decorated with engravings (horses, ibex, deer, mammoths, bovids, etc.) that represent some of the oldest artistic expressions of humanity (around 30,000 BCE).

Remember to check out the museum space and its display of prehistoric artefacts discovered at the site.

### DID YOU KNOW...?

Pair-non-Pair is one of the oldest prehistoric caves, twice as old as Lascaux!




